Consider the following points when you plan your composition:

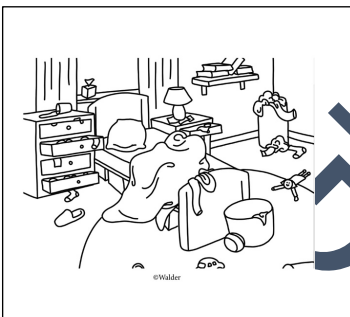
- What was the change?

You are given:

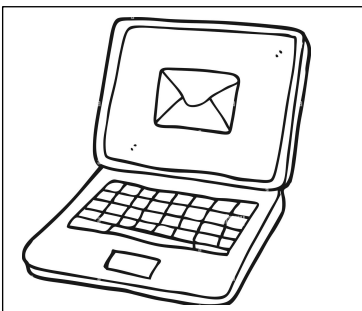

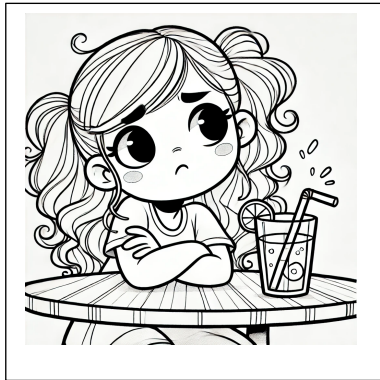
Write a composition of at least 150 words **about a long wait.**

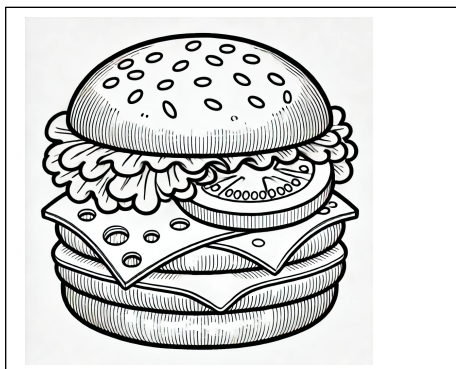

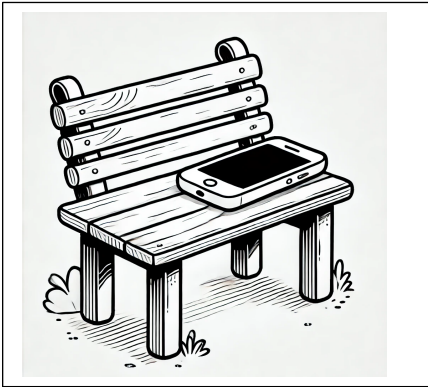
Write a composition of at least 150 words **about something that was lost.**

Consider the following points when you plan your composition:

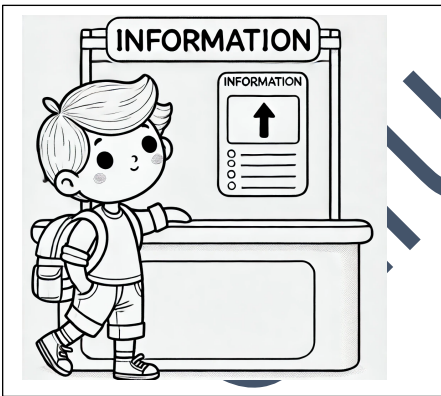
- How did it get lost?

Consider the following points when you plan your composition:

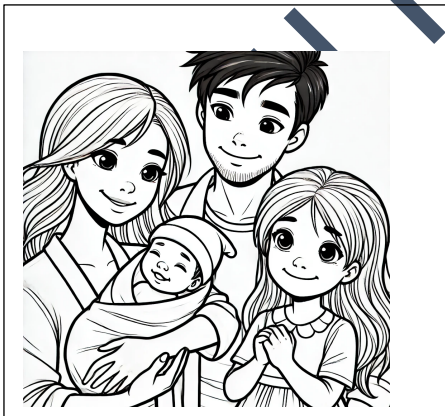
- What was the reason for the celebration?

You are given:

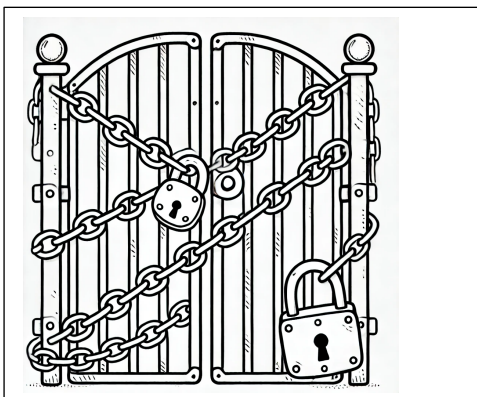
A girl whispering to another girl

Consider the following points when you plan your composition:

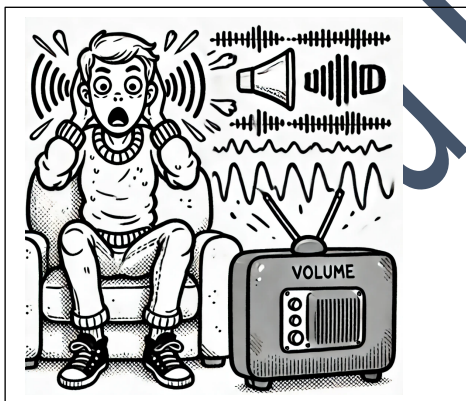
- Who was/were considerate?
